



MSD's Fun Run Frequently Asked Questions

What is the MSD Fun Run?

The Fun Run is a for the whole MSD community as a healthy way to engage our students in giving back to their schools. All students from Toddler to Middle School will be participating in the Fun Run on Friday, September 13.

Here's how it works:

- A two-week pledge period will kick-off with a Pep Rally on Wednesday, September 4 on the Athletic Field.
- After the Rally, families will then begin to gather pledges for every lap their child runs (typically 30-35 laps), during the Fun Run.
- With a goal of raising \$25,000 to support Technology in the classroom students will be encouraged to collect pledges from friends, family, and neighbors through an online fundraising portal.
- Stinger, our wonderful MSD mascot, will be running laps and cheering on every student as they run their laps!

How do parents register their student(s)?

First, parents log in or sign up on www.funrun.com. Then parents can register their student as a participant on funrun.com using the school registration code: 774-677.

How do students get pledges?

Parents can pledge AND help connect their child(ren) to friends, family, and neighbors for additional pledges. Pledges will be accepted online at funrun.com.

Can donors pledge a flat donation or do they need to pledge per lap?

Yes! All flat donations count toward pledges and are rounded by 30 (the average student will run 30 laps). So, a \$30 donation is the same as \$1 a lap. A \$60 donation is the same as \$2 per lap and so forth.

Will my student really run 30 laps? How big is the track?

The Fun Run track is about 1/16th of a mile, 1/4th the size of a normal high school track. The average student will run 30-35 laps and will have a goal to run at least 30 laps to help raise money for their school. The most any student will be counted for is 35 laps.

****Please Note:** This year, our Toddler students will earn 35 laps by completing their Parent Buddy Walk around the Toddler Village, dancing to light music, chasing bubbles from the bubble machine, and just moving their bodies around while having fun staying fit and supporting their school!

Can pledges be paid online?

Yes! Pledges and payments should be made online. Donors will provide an email address at the time they make their pledges and the day after the Fun Run, all donors will receive an email to let them know how many laps their child ran and how to pay their pledges online.

How will my Middle School student participate?

Middle School students will participate in a Buddy Run with the Primary and Kindergarten students at 10:00am and then they will run in their own race at 2:00pm. This is a fun way for our older students to get in on the fun, and be student leaders. They will also be on hand to pass out water to our thirsty competitors and be everyone's cheerleader on Race Day.

What fun incentives will there be for our students?

We have many fun ways to celebrate our successful Fun Run. We have lots of fun in store which includes an Inside Out/Backwards Day, and some cool prizes to make our PE Classes even more fun. When we reach our goal of \$25,000, our wonderful PE teacher, Chris Bangs, has agreed to be "slimed" to celebrate all our hard work. And Julie Bragdon, our Head of School, will be dressing up as her favorite super hero and running with the students to encourage everyone to do their best!
