We have also starting making optional "to-go" materials for Toddler through Lower Elementary students for you to pick-up at MSD on a regular basis, following strict guidelines on distancing and disinfecting. We will be sending out more information about these "to-go" packets by program level soon.

We expect that the Governor will make an announcement regarding Summer Camp in the next two weeks. At that time, we will inform you of what MSD will be doing in June and July, based on the Governor's decision for our state.

As far as graduation and other year-end celebrations, we continue to have a mandate to not gather in groups over 10 so we are busy thinking of dynamic, creative ways to honor our 8th graders and rising students within distancing and gathering constraints. I look forward to sharing these plans soon.
